Minimum Requirements:

- Be persons of good moral character and of high ethical integrity and professional standing, as determined by the Academy's Board of Trustees.

- Possess a degree in environmental engineering or any other engineering field acceptable to the BOT.

- Hold a valid license or certificate of registration to practice professional engineering, issued by the lawfully constituted registration board of any State, territory, possession or district of the United States.

- Be professionally engaged in environmental engineering activities on a full time basis.
